ACTION ITEMS/MOTIONS:

d. <u>Annual Budget:</u> Lynne began by saying that we were able to make the budget without too large a deficit. Bob continued with specifics about the number and amounts of the pledges. Bob said we are in very good shape going into the new budget year. He continued to point out and explain specific items in the budget as well as some minor changes that have been made. Bob concluded by saying that he is confident that the deficit in the budget can be brought into alignment during the year.

Libby Chinman moved that the Vestry accept and present the 2025 budget at the Annual Meeting on January 26, 2025. Motion was seconded by Carole LaBate. The motion passed unanimously.
